Case Management

Supported Employment Services support people in their job roles through individualised plans that develop skills, confidence and independence. We work with each employee to set personal career goals and training opportunities.

Work Experience

Work experience is an unfunded activity offered to people as a 'taster'; to enable them to make a decision about whether they would like to work at Barossa Enterprises, or consider alternate option. People are referred to work experience by services including Disability SA, Families SA, other disability services, or by self referral.

Training

Barossa Enterprises Support Workers provide on-the-job non-accredited training to Supported Employees to support them;

- develop work ethic skills (punctuality, presentation, notification of absences)
- achieve employability skills (Communication, Teamwork, Problem Solving, Initiative, Planning, Self Management, Learning, Technology)
- are able to work safely and in accordance with BE's procedures
